Part 1: Purpose

Article 1-A: Purpose and Mandate

- 1. This document describes the rules related to the Club Space for the Society of Computing and Information Science (SOCIS).
- 2. This policy applies to all shared (physical and virtual) SOCIS Club spaces, as defined in Part 3 of this document. The Makerspace is a SOCIS Club space, and its operations are governed by this document as well as its own policies.

Part 2: Club space rules

Article 2-A: Physical spaces

- 1. SOCIS physical spaces are available for use by all SOCIS members and SOCSSOs.
 - a. SOCIS executive and leaders of SOCSSOs which are not on probation must be given a key or passcode to enter the SOCIS office in Reynolds 0010.
- 2. Personal belongings are not to be left unattended in SOCIS physical spaces.
- 3. Materials in SOCIS club spaces are available for use in the club space only.

Article 2-B: Virtual spaces

- SOCIS virtual spaces are available for use by all SOCIS members and SOCSSOs.
 - a. Virtual spaces may be made available to non-SOCIS members, however they should primarily serve our members and clubs.
- 2. All SOCIS virtual spaces must have a code of conduct for acceptable use.
- 3. Use of SOCIS virtual spaces requires acknowledgement of the code of conduct.
- SOCIS virtual spaces must be moderated by the executive, or a moderation Committee established by the executive.
- 5. Violation of the code of conduct may result in a temporary or permanent ban from SOCIS virtual spaces.

Part 3: Definitions

Article 3-A: Definitions

- 1. Club space: a meeting space designated for SOCIS members.
- 2. Physical space: an on-campus meeting space designated for SOCIS members.
 - a. E.g. SOCIS Office (Reyn 0010).

- 3. Virtual space: an online community designed for SOCIS members.
- 4. Code of conduct: a set of shared expectations for behaviour, used to guide moderation of SOCIS virtual spaces.
- 5. SOCIS members: members of SOCIS, as defined under Article II of the constitution.
